Climate disasters like hurricanes, droughts, floods, and wildfires now happen with more intensity. Many people have to leave home to find a better place to live due to the destruction of land, lack of crops, sea level rise, water scarcity, or even increased fighting due to scarcity of resources. These people are known as climate migrants. The United Nations estimates there are 26 million climate migrants annually, more people than displaced by war. Yet these migrants are not legally considered refugees by international law.

Question to ponder and act upon:

- How does climate and environmental harm affect people who need to migrate from their homes?
- Why is this important background in understanding immigration today?
